### Scholarship Eligibility

Candidates for any of the above-named scholarships must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Resident of the City of Alameda.
- 2. 2018 graduate of a high school in the City of Alameda.
- 3. Must have:
  - a. Applied to a vocational or trade school, or a college or university (collectively "institution") accredited by an agency recognized by the US Department of Education Office of Post-secondary Education; and
  - b. Demonstrated scholastic or other ability.
- 4. Has a financial need, evidenced by the Student Aid Report from the US Department of Education (the candidate must have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- 5. Demonstrates character, integrity and leadership through participation in school and/or extra curricular activities.

### **Funding of the Scholarship**

Funding of Alameda Kiwanis Foundation scholarships is subject to the following:

- 1. Funds will be disbursed after commencement of the academic term each year, payable to the institution and the student.
- 2. Scholarship funds are to be used only for the payment of tuition, room and board, incidental fees, and books.
- 3. Recipient must provide the following yearly documentation:
  - a. Verification of enrollment as a full-time student for the upcoming term at an accredited institution;
  - b. Transcripts from the accredited institution demonstrating a satisfactory scholastic record (not on academic probation) for the preceding academic year.
  - c. The yearly Student Aid Report that demonstrates a continued financial need.
- 4. If at anytime the student does not maintain full time academic status or enrolls in a non-accredited institution, the scholarship will be forfeited and revert back to the Alameda Kiwanis Foundation.

The Scholarship Committee of the Alameda Kiwanis Foundation will consider your application and make its recommendations to the Board of Directors of the Alameda Kiwanis Foundation.
